OhioLINK enables delivery at any participating institution, no matter where your home institution is located. In addition, if you have a valid ID from an OhioLINK institution, you can visit any participating library and borrow circulating items directly without waiting for delivery. It's a good idea to check with the owning library for hours and to verify that the item will actually circulate to OhioLINK members before making a trip.

Shared Collections

Ninety-one OhioLINK libraries make their physical collections available across the state, delivered to the participating library of your choice in 2-3 business days. The shared collections include books, sheet music, and audiovisual materials, among others. In addition, 26 public libraries share their materials with OhioLINK via SearchOhio. OhioLINK funds and manages the central searchable catalog, the requesting software, and the courier service that delivers the material. - Registered students, faculty and staff at the 91 participating academic institutions.
- State employees via the State Library of Ohio, a charter member of OhioLINK.

What is the Electronic Thesis & Dissertation Center?

- The ETD is a searchable online collection of the full text of more than 40,000 dissertations and theses from 26 Ohio institutions of higher education.
- The subject matter covers all disciplines, from Academic Guidance Counselling to Zoology
- Search, browse and download at <https://etd.ohiolink.edu>

- Anyone can use the OhioLINK ETD. The ETD is an open-access resource, meaning anyone with an Internet connection can read the full text of these dissertations and theses.
- Ohio institutions and graduate students get worldwide exposure through the ETD. Since July 2013, the ETD has registered more than 400,000 views from all over the world. The United States generated the most use (197,894), with India (26,793), the United Kingdom (22,384), Canada (13,203) and Australia (10,302) recording significant annual use as well.
